English Boat Championship 2021

It was great to be back at Plymouth to fish the Boat Championship, although in somewhat constrained circumstances. Due to Covid restrictions we were limited to five anglers per boat and no presentation. However, most of us managed to catch up with friends and rivals over the two days.

Day 1 After reports back from the practice day and consultation with the skippers it was decided that all boats would fish The Rutts as the fishing at the Eddystone was poor. Boats were to leave Mountbatten by 7:30. All boats stopped for fresh bait of launce and mackerel, although the mackerel were very few and far between for most. Then it was off to the Rutts to either drift the reefs and surrounding ground for Pollack, Pout, Whiting, Gurnards etc. or anchor up for Conger, Ling and dogfish. The bigger scoring fish Conger, Ling and Pollack were hard to come by on some boats and scores were low. At the end of day one the five boat winners taking 100% through to the next day were Billy Cann on Mirage, Rolf Marschalek on Tamasis, Gary Geoghegan on Patricia Rose, Richard Russell on Crusader and Matt Osborne on Sea Angler II.

Day 2 Again a 7:30 start with a slight drizzle, but fortunately the rain and strong breeze forecast a couple of days earlier never materialised. Some of us were wishing we were in shorts as we fished in sunshine for most of the day. This time most boats headed out to The Eddystone after stopping to bait fish. Fishing tactics were similar to the previous day and again the bigger fish were not playing ball. Back on shore and with the results in both Richard Russell on Sea Angler II and Matt Osborne on Tamasis had again won their boats so both on 200%. On count back Matt was top angler and gold pin winner with 90 fish points. Richard had 88 fish points to take the silver pin. The bronze pin went to Garry Geoghegan with 190.24 %. Other boat winners were Dave Cogger on Patricia Rose, Barrie Senior on Crusader and Ray Barron on Mirage.

Longest Ling prize went to Matt Osborne with a fish of 107cm.

The Four Man Drawn Team winners were the team of Gary Galbraith, Gary Geoghegan, Ray Barron and Barrie Senior.

Top boat over the 2 days, taking the average score for the anglers on that boat each day and adding them together, was Mirage.

As we were not able to hold a presentation pins will be presented at the AGM. Andy Selby will be sending out vouchers to all winners. Many thanks to all of you for supporting the Section in these difficult times which have caused the cancellation of our events over the last 15 months and forced us to put restrictions on this one.

2021 EFSA European Shore Angling Championships

The Covid 19 postponed 2020 EFSA Shore Angling Championships were re-arranged for competition from September 29th to October 2nd, 2021. The HQ venue was The Upton Court Hotel in Kilmuckridge, Co. Wexford where the parade of national flags & opening ceremony took place on the evening of Wednesday September 29th. This was followed by the zone draw where competitors were allocated their daily beach sections. Competing Nations were: England, Germany, Iceland, Netherlands, Wales & hosts, Ireland.

The 59 competitors from the 6 nations assembled on Thursday morning for bait distribution at 10.30AM with a planned fishing session on Morriscastle Beach from 2pm to 7pm. The supplied baits were mackerel, sandeel, black lug wraps, king rag & harbour rag (maddies). High winds & a driving surf however forced a 1 hour delay reducing the allocated fishing time to 4 hours. The anglers assembled at their zones to draw their zone position & the match got underway at 3pm.

The fishing was extremely slow with very few fish being captured early on. It did pick up somewhat later, but only 106 fish were recorded for the 4 hour session. Zone winners were Stephen Glynn (IRE, day winner), Micheál Quinn (IRE), Reg Clough (ENG), John O'Connor (WAL), Wilco Keur (NED) & Warren Doyle (IRE) joint winners in Zone C. Best round fish was a superb 50cm Bass for John Hughes (IRE) & best flat fish was a 33cm Flounder for Don Scott (IRE).

Day winner Stephen Glynn set about defending his title won in Iceland in 2019 with the best score on the day, 246 points.

Best Lady was Katharina Schleiff (GER), best Junior was Ove Hansen (GER) & best Senior (over 65) was John O'Connor (WAL).

The venue for day 2 was Clone Strand (Kilgorman) where fishing got underway at 2pm for a 5 hour session. Fishing was again very slow with some sections having no fish early on. When lines in was called the zone winners were: Stephen Glynn defending his title in style with another day win, Wilco Keur also recorded his second win, Paul Whelan (IRE), Volker Claus (GER) & Helgi Bergsson (ICE) were the other zone winners.

A total of 179 fish were recorded on day 2.

Best round fish, a 97cm Smoothound was captured by Hans Juergen Glaeser (GER).

Best flat fish was a 32cm Thornback Ray for Marcus Wuest (GER).

Best after day 2 were: Lady, Anne Whitty (IRE), Junior, Ove Hansen, Senior, Warren Doyle (IRE).

Day 3 had the anglers at Curracloe Beach for an 11am start for their 5 hour session. Torrential rain marred the first 2 hours however the fishing was better than the previous 2 days with many anglers recording fish on their first cast. The all day rising tide gave a big improvement in the capture rate with 330 fish recorded for the session. Reports along the beach were that Paul Whelan was fairly rocking the fish in & so it proved

when he took the day win with 31 fish for 830 points. The other zone winners were: Andreas Burkhardt (GER), Helgi Bergsson, Mike Flynn (WAL) & J. P. Molloy (IRE). Best Lady on day 3 was Anne Whitty, best Junior was Nathan Kearns (IRE) & best Senior was Dave Lovelock (ENG).

Best round fish was a 43cm bass for Andreas Burkhardt. Best flat fish were 4 X 30cm flounders.

Species recorded during the event were: Common Eel, Bass, Dab, Flounder, Tub Gurnard, Grey Gurnard, Lesser Spotted Dogfish, Plaice, Thornback Ray, Rockling & Smoothhound.

The Gala Dinner & Prize presentation took place at The Upton Court Hotel at 8pm. The anglers, wives, partners & guests enjoyed a wonderful meal prior to the awarding of prizes.

EFSA Ireland Chairman George McCullough opened the proceedings. He thanked those who had worked to make the event the success that it was. He also thanked the staff who had very professionally & efficiently served the meal. He made special mention to those who had supported the EFSA Ireland organising committee with running the event: TronixPro Fishing Tackle, Inland Fisheries Ireland, Wexford County Council, Swords Angling, Southside Angling, Waterford Outdoor & Angling Centre, Waterford Glass, Atlantic Sales, without whose support the event would have been impossible to host.

The awards were presented by EFSA Shore Festival Officer, Phil Lustig & the much coveted Gold, Silver & Bronze Lapel Pins were affixed by EFSA President, Marcus Wuest.

Standing Committee Delegate's Report

The latest Standing Committee Meeting was held at Kilmuckridge on 29 September 2021 at the EFSA Shore Championship with many participants joining by Zoom. After the Chairman's welcome and apologies for absence, anglers who had passed away recently were remembered, these being EFSA Wales President Reno Ranesto & EFSA Germany's Carl Werner Schmidt-Luchs.

The following is a resumee of the major items discussed:

1. The minutes of the last SC Meeting were approved with no matters arising.
2. OPES (Italy) have applied to host an EFSA Shore Championship. This will be considered at next HQ meeting.
3. EFSA England results programme is being run in parallel to the one used by Ireland at the shore championships.
4. The Boat Championships 2022 in Denmark will be run over 4 days only. If possible EFSA will try to provide practice boats on the other day. There will be no size limits. HQ representative asked that a minimum hook size be considered. 5mm gape suggested. List of accommodation providers to be provided.
5. The Boat Championship 2023 in Ireland will be September which conflicts with Species event scheduled for England at same time. EFSA England said they will move their event to possibly July for Bream.
6. EFSA Iceland have requested that sections pre-register their anglers in January 2022 in order that they can ensure sufficient boats are available for the competition.
7. Sweden have advised they will not be able to run the Species Championship 2024. Looking for another Section to host this.
8. Shore Championship 2022 Wales. The Welsh Section are unable to run this. Netherlands will look to see if there is a possibility, they can hold it but not hopeful.

9. Shore Championship 2023 Netherlands depends on 2022 but also, they have a shortage of manpower. EFSA Germany and Wales maybe be able to help out.
10. Game Championship 2022 Cape Verde. EFSA Netherlands advised some boats have been upgraded & will require extra costs. EFSA Ireland reported difficulty with getting flights.
11. Future Game events, EFSA Ireland are investigating the possibility of holding an event in 2024 for Tuna.
12. European Anglers Alliance have advised that as an international organisation EFSA does not fit their membership requirements. Affiliate status may be possible. It was agreed by the Committee that this should be pursued.
13. Discussion of Line Class applications whether weights should be in Metric only. Deferred to next meeting.
14. It was agreed that that the minimum weight for new species entries would be 450 grammes.
15. Line Class it was agreed to open all categories to 2lb up to 16lb.
16. There was a lengthy discussion on when membership fees were paid to sections and subsequent payment of HQ dues in January. As sections had differing timelines for collecting membership. Referred to HQ to discuss and propose a path forward.
17. Review of Rules published on efsafishing.org website. EFSA Chairman tasked Festival Officers to review SC/AGM minutes back to 15 March 2015 to ensure published rules were up to date. The EFSA Secretary also thought the Constitution may also need reviewing.
18. The rules on Dress Code were discussed at length as it was felt that cost of the uniform was deterring new members especially youngsters. Time have changed and more modern wear should possibly be adopted such as polo shirts with section identification. HQ will prepare draft formal wording for consideration.
19. The EFSA Secretary reported that “drawn” teams format was a deterrent to recruiting new younger members. After much discussion it was decided to leave the rule as stands.
20. Drones. Clarify status. Following a lengthy discussion, it was agreed that drones are not permitted under any circumstances in EFSA events.
21. Date and venue for next SC Meeting 29 April 2022 agreed. Venue to be advised.
